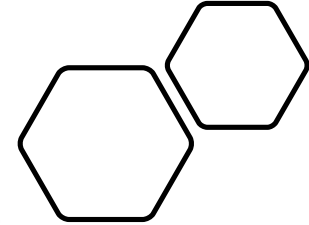

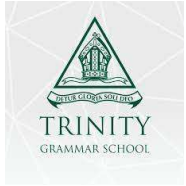

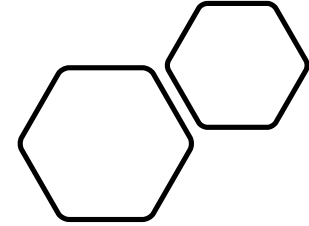

Ordinances



“An ordinance to clarify the doctrines tenets and beliefs of the Diocese for the use of church property”

Our doctrines tenets and beliefs are found in the Property Use Policy

Ordinances



The application of this ordinance hinges on the definition of 'church worker' but applies to principals, chaplains and teachers employed to teach any subject deemed *religious*

The Anglican Church of Australia is committed to the physical, emotional and spiritual welfare and safety to all people ... (General Synod)

Ordinances



Your school is in a parish.
It is therefore part of the local parish's
ministry unless it is declared
extra-parochial.

Extra-parochial schools may select their
chaplain, but the Archbishop appoints
them. In schools that are NOT extra-
parochial the parish rector is the chaplain

Objects:

To serve Christ by equipping students for his world through efficiently operating strategically placed Anglican educational establishments that –

Anglican Schools Corporation 1947

Corporation Powers:

- (a) control, manage and conduct the Schools;
- (b) promote, acquire and establish other schools ...
- (c) make such arrangements, financial or otherwise for the development, extension and improvement of the Schools; and
- (d) order and conduct the affairs of the Schools ...

Ordinances



Anglican Schools Corporation 1947

Councils' Powers:

The responsibilities of a School Council include –

(a) ... ensuring that it operates in a manner that –

- (i) upholds the Corporation's Objects,
- (ii) supports the Corporation's Philosophy of Education, and
- (iii) implements the School's strategic plan ... and

Anglican Schools Corporation 1947

Councils' Powers:

(b) developing the individual character of the School ... in the context of its local environment and in a relationship of interdependence with the Corporation; and

Ordinances



Anglican Schools Corporation 1947

Councils' Powers:

(c) to be satisfied ... that any person proposed to be appointed by the Board as the Principal of a School ... is suitably qualified and experienced ... and is a person of Christian faith and character who attends regularly and is actively involved in a Bible-based Christian Church and who is committed to and capable of furthering allegiance to Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour.

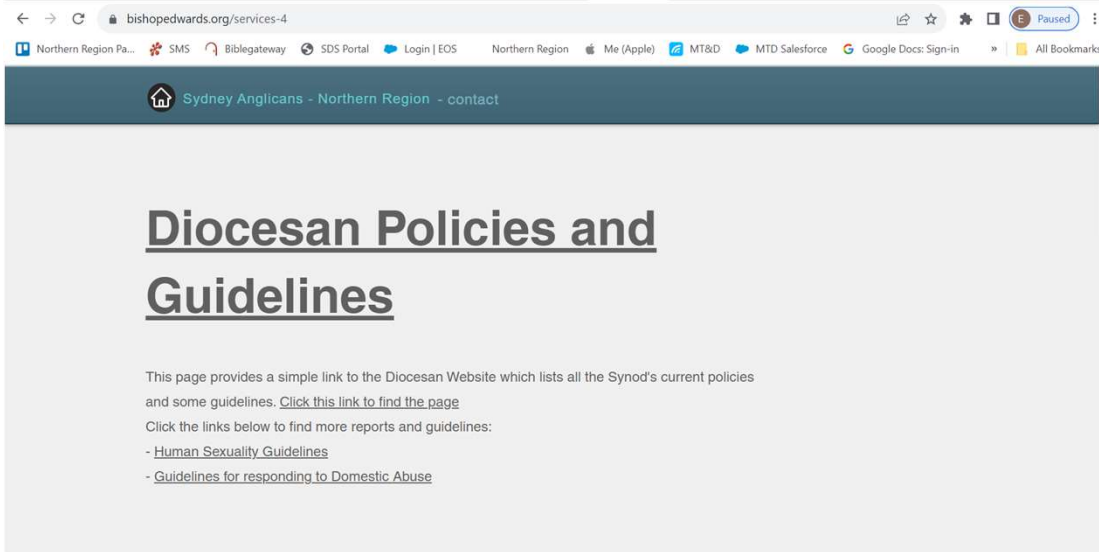
